Sustainable maritime transport with LNG between Greek mainland and islands in the Archipelagos

This project covers a study aiming to promote the use of LNG (liquefied natural gas) as a marine fuel in the passenger and shipping sectors of the Greek islands, in order to reduce supply costs and the environmental impact of oil derivative-based fuels. The main objective is to motivate and to provide the Greek authorities with the necessary tools in order to adopt a regulatory framework for the bunkering of gas-fuelled (LNG) ships in the region. The project brings together key Greek stakeholders representing a cross-section of the LNG as marine fuel supply chain including national ministerial and regional authorities, LNG suppliers, ship owners/operators and shipyards, supported by academic/research institutes.
